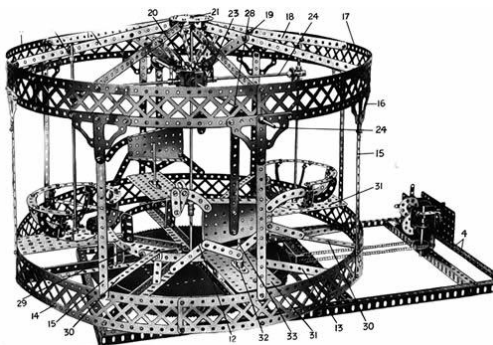
M Shed and My future My Choice are recruiting engineers to a programme funded by the Royal Academy of Engineers to –
